Disabled Shelter Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance for use of the shelter by disabled supporters.

- The shelter is for the use of any disabled supporter that cannot access the stand due to their disability.
 - The shelter has space for 8 wheelchairs/strollers, and this number should not be exceeded on grounds of safety. Should this number be exceeded on any matchday, the supporter should follow the instructions of Disability Access Officer (DAO) and head steward.
 - Personal Assistant/carer (PA) seating is provided in the stand and when shelter is busy this should be used unless PA has to be next to disabled person for medical reasons.
 - If the maximum number of disabled supporters in the shelter is reached on a match day, then priority should be given to those who are unable to access seats in the stand and supporters that do not have a mobility disability should sit in the stand.
 - In the event of an emergency requiring evacuation of the shelter follow the direction of the stewards. The preferred route of egress would be out the gate, onto the park and along the front of the stand to exit the ground via the metal gates between the west and south stands.
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This Document is for guidance only and may be changed if the situation requires this for health and safety reasons.
